CANADIAN BOARDING

Canadian boarding fees apply to: 1) students who have Canadian citizenship and 2) residents of the USA or Bermuda. †To qualify for the cost savings offered under the Canadian Families Boarding Incentive Programme, which is based on Grade 9 entry on or after the 2014-2015 school year, students MUST hold Canadian citizenship.

*FIRST YEAR STUDENTS ONLY

A one-time non-refundable initiation fee of \$2,000 (Grade 9-10) or \$3,000 (Grade 11-12) must accompany your signed enrolment agreement. The initiation fee is in addition to the tuition fees noted above.

ADDITIONAL COSTS BEYOND TUITION

- Uniform and books (approx. \$2,000): depending on course selection and level as well as uniform requirements.
- An international health insurance plan (approx. \$675 for the year) is offered to all international, non-Canadian students.

TUITION REFUND PLAN

The Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) is mandatory for all families on the quarterly or monthly payment plan and optional for families choosing the full payment plan. The premium is calculated at 1.69% of the total tuition fee, less any financial assistance awarded, plus Ontario sales tax of 8%. TRP is billed to the account in August.

PAYMENT METHODS

Payments may be made by electronic bill payment (available through most Canadian financial institutions), credit card, cheque, cash or bank wire transfer.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAYMENT OF FEES

- Parents or individuals accepting financial responsibility are accountable for the full fees if students are dismissed or withdrawn during the school year.
- Monthly account balances not paid within 30 days of the statement date will be subject to an interest charge of 1.5% per month (18% per annum).
- The School reserves the right to levy specific late payment charges on any tuition fee payment that is 30 days in arrears as follows:
 - Late Full Tuition Fee Payment: \$300
 - Late Quarterly Tuition Fee Payment: \$75
 - Late Monthly Tuition Fee Payment: \$30
- Students will not be admitted to the School in September unless the fees are paid up to date as per this fee table.
- The School reserves the right to exercise sanctions, which may include suspension, as it deems necessary for the collection of overdue accounts.

SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARY CREDITS

Tuition payments may be reduced if the student has been awarded financial assistance. Awards will be credited to the account at the time of billing as follows:

- Full payment: 100% of the award will be credited in June.
- Quarterly payment: 25% of the award will be credited in June, September, December and March.
- Monthly payment: 10% of the award will be credited each month from June to March.

PERSONAL EXTRA AND INCIDENTAL CHARGES

Incidental charges, as described in our various publications, are billed on a monthly basis and are payable upon receipt of the monthly statement of account. These charges include but are not limited to:

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

The School's admissions office must receive written notification of the intent to withdraw any student for the upcoming year. A returning student may be withdrawn on or before May 1st without forfeiture of the down payment. A new student may be withdrawn on or before May 1st with all but \$500 of the down payment being refundable. If a student is withdrawn during the period of May 2nd through June 12th, the entire down payment is forfeited. Effective June 13th, the family becomes liable for the full tuition fees for the entire school year.
